Supplementary assessments (G13.5 and G15.1) A supplementary assessment is one granted (where the rules for the qualification permit it and in terms of conditions set out in Faculty Standing Orders) to a student who has failed a course. Supplementary assessments should be compiled at the same time as the final assessment and be subject to the same practises and moderation procedures. Where a supplementary assessment is granted, the final resultant mark may only be recorded as a pass (with the appropriate minimum pass mark) or a fail. The result of the supplementary assessment may form the total and final reassessment of a student's performance in a course and no account needs to be taken of the course mark. A student who does not present himself/herself for a supplementary assessment shall not be entitled or permitted to have that assessment deferred unless there are in the opinion of the Senate exceptional grounds for permitting the student to do so. Start main page content Deferred assessments (General Rule 13.6) A deferred assessment is one awarded in terms of the rules by the Dean or his/her duly appointed agent, on application, to a student who, by reason of illness, religious scruples or some other good and sufficient cause, has either failed to attend or complete his/her assessment(s), or who would suffer hardship to an exceptional degree if compelled to complete his/her assessment(s) at the normal time. A deferred examination will not be granted without supporting documentation. A deferred assessment may be in any format as determined by the Head of School including an oral examination and should bear the same relationship to the course mark as did the original assessment. A deferred assessment will be awarded under the following conditions: Illness A candidate who is unable to take an assessment because of illness may be granted a deferred assessment if s/he produces the standard health application form (available from the Student Self-Service portal) completed by a Health Professional. If deemed necessary the student may be referred to a Health Professional at the Campus Health and Wellness Centre for further evaluation. Any certificates obtained by professionals who may be family members or friends and which may constitute a conflict of interest, will not be accepted by the University. If a candidate applies for deferment on the grounds of illness suffered before an assessment, although he or she may have recovered by the date of the assessment, the medical certificate must describe the nature and degree of disability, which interrupted the candidate's preparation for the assessment. A candidate who falls ill during an assessment must report immediately to the Chief Invigilator who will arrange for him or her to be accompanied to the Campus Health and Wellness Centre (CHWC) (see 1.12.12). If s/he is unable to complete the assessment a deferred assessment may be granted to the candidate if he or she is certified as being unfit to complete the assessment by CHWC. Save as provided in Rule G.13.7 and 1.19 below it will not avail a candidate who presents himself or herself for an assessment and takes it when ill, to produce a doctor's certificate after having taken the assessment. In cases where acute assessment anxiety produces illness, a deferred assessment may be granted on the first occasion that this occurs, but the candidate must be informed that unless he or she undertakes the course of treatment offered by the Counselling and Careers Development Unit (CCDU), no further such deferrals will be granted. Religious grounds A candidate who objects to taking an assessment on a recognised University holy day of his/her particular faith must submit a letter of support for his/her application for a deferred assessment from the religious leader of that faith. Sporting or cultural commitments A candidate may be granted a deferred assessment if s/he has been selected to participate in a sporting, cultural or similar event, as a formal representative of the University, province or country, or in a capacity considered equivalent by the Dean's representative who will consider, inter alia, whether the timing of such an event would constitute a serious impediment, either to the candidate's presence at the assessment, and/or to the candidate's preparation for the assessment. Other grounds An application for a deferred assessment on grounds other than those listed above will be considered on its merits. Save in exceptional circumstances, nothing can be done for a candidate who misreads the assessment timetable Students will not be granted a deferred examination based on travel/family events as examination dates are published in advance of the examinations. An application for a deferred formal assessment must, except in exceptional circumstances, be completed and returned within three working days of the date on which the assessment was due to be taken. Students are obliged to identify themselves positively by means of a valid student card when writing a test or examination. No access to the test or examination venue will be allowed without a valid student card. 2. No person may pretend to be a registered student and/or write a test or examination on behalf of a student. 3. No student may enter the test or examination venue later than half an hour after the commencement of a test or examination session. No student may leave the test or examination venue earlier than half an hour after the commencement of a test or examination session. 4. Students must obey all the instructions given by an invigilator immediately and strictly. 5. Students may not bring into the test or examination venue or have in their possession any of the following: bags (satchels) handbags pencil cases or bags unauthorized apparatus books electronic means of communication or similar devices cellular phone watches (smartwatches) or cellular phones (cellular phones may not be used as a substitute for calculators) any piece of paper, no matter how small notes of any nature whatsoever. It is important that the surname, full names, and signature of the student are provided in the relevant space on the test or examination answer script. If so preferred by the student, this information may be treated as confidential by folding and sealing the top portion of the examination or test answer script. 7. Once the invigilator has announced the commencement of the test or examination, all conversation or any other form of communication between students must cease. During the course of the test or examination, no communication of any nature whatsoever may take place between students. 8. No student may assist or attempt to assist another student, or obtain help, or attempt to obtain help from another student during a test or examination. 9. Writing on any paper other than that provided for test or examination purposes is strictly prohibited. Students may also not write on the test or examination paper, except in the case of fill-in and multiple-choice question papers. 10. Rough work should be done in the test or examination answer script and then crossed out. No pages may be removed from the test or examination answer script. 11. Smoking is not permitted in the test or examination venue, and students will also not be permitted to leave the venue during the test or examination for this purpose. 12. Only in exceptional circumstances will a student be given permission to leave the test or examination venue temporarily, and then only under the supervision of an invigilator. 13. Students may not take used or unused answer scripts from the test or examination venue. 14. As soon as the invigilator announces during a test or examination that the time has expired, students should stop writing immediately.
